RIBSA CODE OF CONDUCT SANCTIONS



Yellow – Verbal warning

- (1) Failure to sign a Player or Officials International Contract within 4 weeks of being selected or nominated.
- (2) Failure to play on any table as directed by T D or assistant T D.
- (3) (2) Failure to pay monies owed to RIBSA within 4 weeks of being notified.



Green – Letter of warning

- (1) Failure to comply with the Verbal warning within 4 weeks.
- (2) Minor case of verbal abuse



Brown – 6 Month Total Ban: (From All RIBSA / International Events from Date of Offence)

- (1) Failure to comply with a written warning.
- (2) Verbal abuse to a Player or Official at an official event *
- (3) Giving the wrong date of birth for under age events.
- (4) Missing an Opening or Closing Ceremony at an International event without permission from RIBSA Official or TD
- (5) Being removed from or missing an International match.
- (6) Failure to appear on time for an International match.



Blue – 1 year Total Ban: (From All RIBSA / International Events from Date of Offence)

- (1) Junior (Under 18) drinking Alcohol at an official event *
- (2) Drunken Behaviour at any Official Event by any RIBSA Member.
- (3) Behaviour that results in being removed completely from an official event *
- (4) Throwing, fixing or losing match on purpose.
- (5) Behaviour that brings RIBSA into disrepute

Pink – 2 years Total Ban: (From All RIBSA / International Events from Date of Offence)

- (1) Physical abuse to a Player or Official at an official Event *
- (2) Causing property damage at an Official Event *



Black – 5 years Total Ban: (From All RIBSA / International Events from Date of Offence)

- (1) Serious misbehaviour that results in personal injury or substantial damage to property at an official event *
- (2) Giving the wrong name/postal address for Official RIBSA Use in Garda Vetting.
- (3) Failure to agree to or pass a drug test in or out of competition.

Anything not covered in the above will be dealt with by the officers of RIBSA to decide into which category it falls and that decision will be final.

* An Official event in Ireland means from the Opening Ceremony to the Closing Ceremony.

* An Official event outside Ireland means from you leave Ireland to the time you return.
