

Minutes of 2019 AGM:

The minutes of the 2019 AGM were taken as read and proposed as an accurate account of that meeting by Ger Murray and seconded by Neil Shanahan.

Secretary's report:

Tony Thorpe in his report said the previous few months were among the most challenging ever experienced by RIBSA. Along with the rest of the world RIBSA has had to adapt and plan for the future. The "Return to Snooker" protocols developed over the lockdown period were submitted and accepted by Sport Ireland, thanks to all who contributed.

Tony was delighted to report that two of the issues closest to his heart, governance and on-line registration have now come to fruition. Last year RIBSA declared compliance to the "Good Governance Code" and governance is included on the agendas of all council meetings. The secretary noted that RIBSA president Jim Leacy has successfully completed a course in governance organised by Sport Ireland.

The secretary also said after several years attempting to purchase a suitable online registration and payment system RIBSA decided to ask a Carlow web developer Jason Roycroft to create a bespoke system suitable to our needs. Along with developing a new website this work is almost complete. PJ Nolan and Jim Leacy oversaw this work.

Tony thanked all who helped run our many events. Without their help RIBSA's job would be next to impossible. Tony added that he would not be seeking re-election as national secretary this year. He paid tribute to the many people he worked with over the past 11 years and thanked all who helped him perform his duties as secretary. Going forward the secretary said he was confident that SBIreland would continue the good work of RIBSA and with the help of all involved Irish Snooker and Billiards has a bright future.

Treasurers Report:

The treasurer presented the RIBSA accounts for 2019 as audited by Farren Roarty, Chartered Certified Accountants and Registered Auditors. Income for the year amounted to epsilon124,813 and expenditure epsilon124,178 giving a surplus for the year in the amount of epsilon635. This left a retained surplus of epsilon16.093 carried forward to 2019. The Sports Council grant for 2019 was epsilon70,000.

Anti-doping report:

Anti-doping officer Jim Leacy asked that all members acquaint themselves with performance enhancing substances banned by WADA. The current list can be accessed by clicking the link on the new website www.sbireland.ie.

This is especially important for those players on international duty. Jim said our sports were considered low risk by Sport Ireland.

Ranking Tournaments:

National coach PJ Nolan presented detailed reports of the senior, master's, intermediate, junior, ladies, and billiards ranking series. These reports were prepared by the various tour administrators and reflected the effects of the Covid-19 pandemic. Going forward the new council will attempt to organise our tournaments in the coming season to best suit our needs. Members are asked to bear in mind that lockdown rules and restrictions may make it necessary to amend our calendar as changes are introduced.

At all times, the health and wellbeing of our members will be paramount and the advice and guidance of the HSE and sport Ireland will be adhered to.

RIBSA ladies tour continues to be a challenge with small numbers attending events. RIBSA will continue to engage with Sport Ireland and RILSA in attempting to develop the lady's tour.

The tour administrators thanked all the players who participated and congratulated those who achieved success. All the players who represented RIBSA at international events were also congratulated. Special congratulations were offered to the master's team who won the home international title for the first time, the Celtic Challenge team who retained their title. Dylan Rees for winning 2 WDBS events, UK masters champion Michael Judge, Rodney Goggins for winning a Legends qualifying tournament and of course Aaron Hill who became the first player in history to win both the EBSA European U/18 and U/21 titles at the same championships.

In his report he said he has contacted as many clubs as possible but as a result of the lockdown many were closed. John will continue to encourage all clubs to register with our association. He noted with pleasure that Liam Mellowes club in Wexford won the 2020 RIBSA Club of the Year award.

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

RIBSA Company Limited by Guarantee is a company limited by guarantee incorporated and registered in the Republic of Ireland. The registered number of the company is . The registered office of the company is Unit 8 Barrow Valley Retail Park, Sleaty Road, Craigcullen, Co Carlow, Ireland which is also the principal place of business of the company. The nature of the company's operations and its principal activities are set out in the Directors' Report. The financial statements have been presented in Euro (€) which is also the functional currency of the company.

2. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The following accounting policies have been applied consistently in dealing with items which are considered material in relation to the company's financial statements.

Statement of compliance

The financial statements of the company for the financial year ended 31 December 2020 have been prepared on the going concern basis and in accordance with FRS 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" (FRS 102).

Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared on the going concern basis and in accordance with the historical cost convention except for certain properties and financial instruments that are measured at revalued amounts or fair values, as explained in the accounting policies below. Historical cost is generally based on the fair value of the consideration given in exchange for assets. The financial reporting framework that has been applied in their preparation is the Companies Act 2014 and FRS 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" issued by the Financial Reporting Council.

The company qualifies as a small company as defined by section 280A of the Companies Act 2014 in respect of the financial year, and has applied the rules of the 'Small Companies Regime' in accordance with section 280C of the Companies Act 2014.

Income

Revenue comprises the invoice value of goods supplied by the company, exclusive of trade discounts and value added tax.

Property, plant and equipment and depreciation

Property, plant and equipment are stated at cost or at valuation, less accumulated depreciation. The charge to depreciation is calculated to write off the original cost or valuation of property, plant and equipment, less their estimated residual value, over their expected useful lives as follows:

Trade and other creditors

Employee benefits

The company operates a defined contribution pension scheme. The assets of the scheme are held separately from those of the company in an independently administered fund. The company also operates a defined benefit pension scheme for its employees providing benefits based on final pensionable pay. The assets of this scheme are also held separately from those of the company, being invested with pension fund managers.

Taxation

The company has been granted tax exemption under Section 235 of the Taxes Consolidation Act 1997 as a sporting body.
